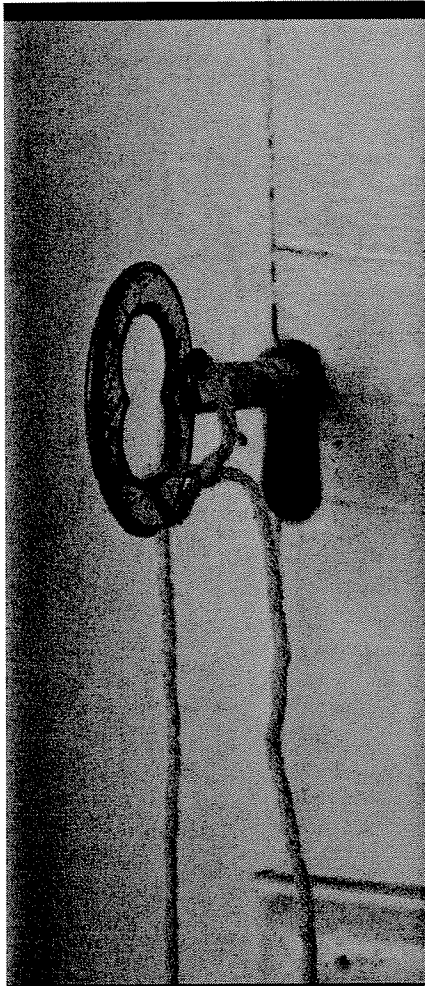
Worcester Homeless Action Committee
