2025 Summer Youth Employment RFP Q&A

Q: Will the grant fund newly recruited youth only, or could the funding be used for youth already employed by the agency?

A: The grant can cover youth that has worked for your organization previously.

Q: What is the requirement with the certificate of liability and what if our current coverage is at a lower level than the RFR requires?

A: The following is required for certificates of insurance as applicable - 1. General liability insurance 2. Workers' compensation and employer liability insurance 3. Automobile liability insurance 4. Third party fidelity bond 5. Umbrella liability insurance. Please reference the RFP for further details. If current coverage is lower than what is required of the RFP, applicants will need to raise coverage to comply with RFP requirements.

Q: Can a housing site apply to employ youth on site, or is the intent to employ out in the community?

A: A housing site can apply as long there is a plan to meet the program requirements, including training and supervision.

Q: We have a Food Pantry on site, could we apply for youth to work there?

A: Yes, so long as the youth will be trained and supported

Q: Is there a minimum number of youth that can be employed? Can a site submit an application for 1-2 youth?

A: There is not a minimum; a proposal can be submitted for 1-2 youth and applications should outline how they will recruit, train, and supervise the youth employees.

Q: What is the "proposal" on the checklist, if different from the components that are listed?

A: The "proposal" section on the checklist is reference the **full** proposal/combined package which includes sections A-N which must be submitted in the order provided in the RFP. Please see RFP for further details.

Q: What is the total amount available for this year's Summer Youth Employment program and what is the maximum available to each applicant?

A: The total amount available for the 2025 Summer Youth Employment program is \$450,000. The maximum amount available to each applicant is \$75,000.
